

#### FROM LITTLE ROCK:

From Little Rock take Interstate 40 West to Conway. The 3rd exit in Conway is Hwy 65 North (about 25 miles from LR). You will take Hwy 65 into Harrison (about 100 miles - cross the Buffalo River etc). Stay on the bypass when you enter Harrison. Turn right on Cottonwood Road. This road is just before the Taco Bell and just after the KFC and some frozen custard place. You'll go through one light on Cottonwood and just follow this 2 lane blacktop road until it deadends into Dubuque Road - about 10 miles. On the way you'll go down a pretty steep hill, then cross the Bear Creek Bridge (you'll see an old swinging bridge to the left - a pretty neat spot for a stop). Stay to the left just after the bridge. It's then about 2 miles to the end of Cottonwood. Turn right on Dubuque Road - this is gravel - and just follow it for about 3 and half miles. You'll again go down a steep hill (almost there) and you'll cross railroad tracks at the bottom (do look for trains - they don't travel fast, but they do go by a couple of times a day). Continue almost a mile further - the schoolhouse is on the left. You'll see a mowed lawn and a privet hedge. The gray gate will be open just past the hedge.

#### FROM BRANSON

Continue South on 65 through Branson into Arkansas. From the little town of Burlington, AR (just south of Omaha, AR on Highway 65 S.) continue on Highway 65 South for 2.4 miles and turn left on Dubuque Road. This section of Dubuque Road is paved for 5 or so miles until it reaches the intersection with Cottonwood Road. Continue straight on Dubuque and at this point it turns to gravel. Just follow it for about 3 and half miles. You'll go down a steep hill (almost there) and you'll cross railroad tracks at the bottom (do look for trains - they don't travel fast, but they do go by a couple of times a day). Continue almost a mile further - the schoolhouse is on the left. You'll see a mowed lawn and a privet hedge. The gray gate will be open just past the hedge. You'll see a litte sign that reads "CSH",
